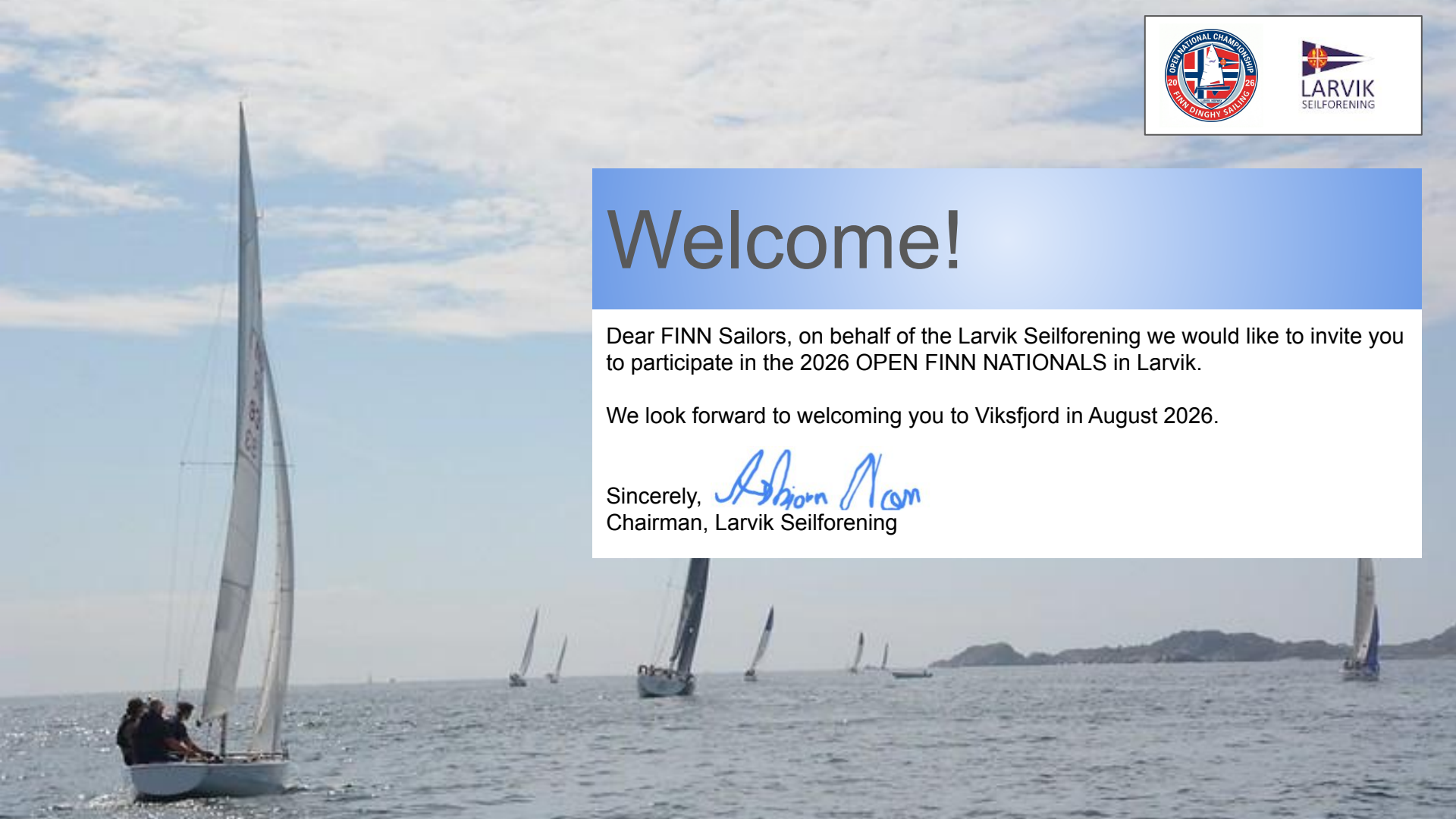

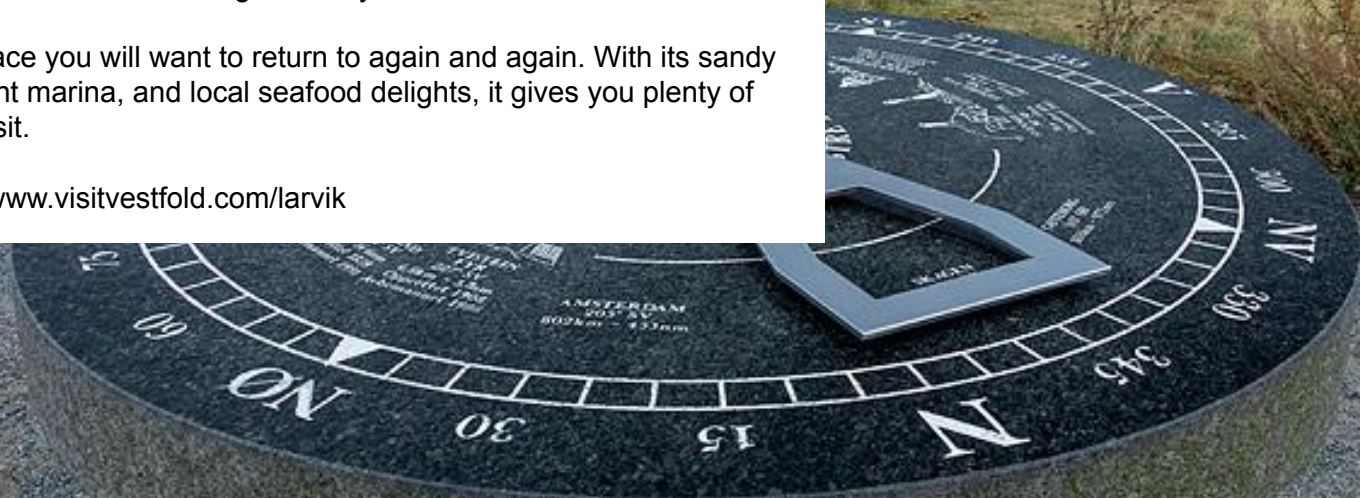
The southern coast of Norway

The Sailing Club

The Start

Larvik Seilforening was founded in 1889 by a group of sailing enthusiasts who wanted to promote sailing along the beautiful Larvik coastline. The club quickly grew, becoming a hub for both recreational and competitive sailing in the region.

Facts

- Active sections: Dinghy, Keelboat, Youth sailing, and Coastal racing
- Approx. 400 members
- Organizes around 6 sailing events per year, including local regattas and seasonal races





Race Village

The race village is planned to be centered at Larvik Seilforening's facilities in Viksfjord, right by the scenic shoreline.

Everything from boat docking, accommodation, and dining is planned to take place at the race village.

For family and friends, the village is a gateway to all the adventures of the Larvik coast. Explore nearby beaches, hiking trails, and local attractions, or enjoy the charm of Larvik town just a short drive away.



Accomodation

Race Village – Viksfjord

Camping can be arranged at the race village, providing a convenient and social base for sailors and families.

Directions



Airport

- Sandefjord Airport, Torp (TRF) – approximately 30 minutes by car
- Oslo Airport, Gardermoen (OSL) – approximately 2 hours by car

Car

- From Oslo: about 2 hours via E18
- From Kristiansand: about 3 hours via E18

Ferry

- Color Line ferry from Hirtshals (Denmark) to Larvik – direct connection to town center and short drive to the race village

General directions

Follow E18 towards Larvik.

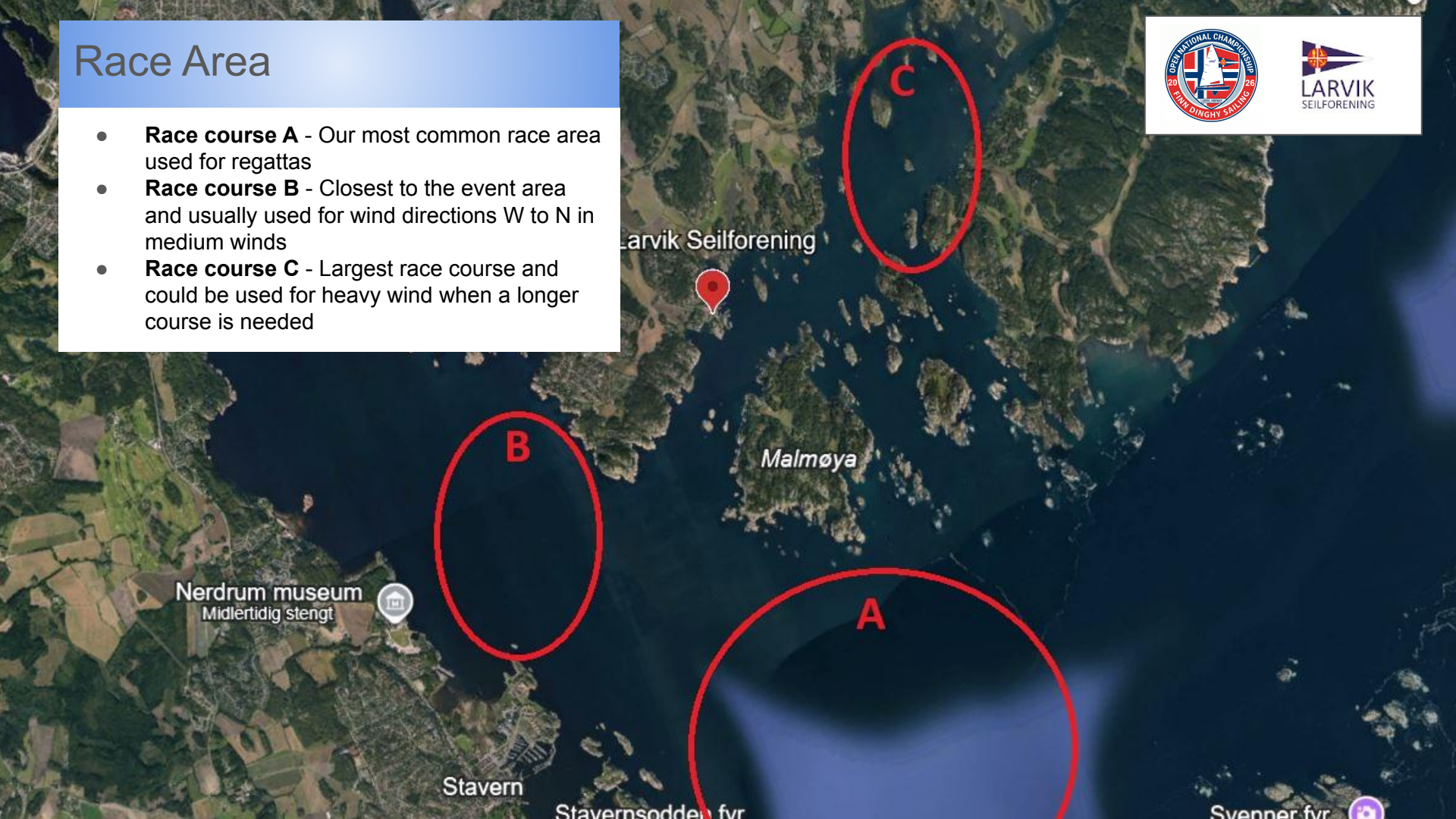
- Turn off at the Viksfjord exit for Larvik Seilforening
- Follow signs to the sailing club and race village

Race Area

- **Race course A** - Our most common race area used for regattas
- **Race course B** - Closest to the event area and usually used for wind directions W to N in medium winds
- **Race course C** - Largest race course and could be used for heavy wind when a longer course is needed



Social Program

Throughout the championship week, a variety of social activities will be held, giving participants and families a great opportunity to meet and enjoy time together in a friendly atmosphere.

- **Friday, 14 August | Opening Ceremony** – Kick off the event and meet fellow sailors.
- **Saturday, 15 August | Barbecue Buffet** – Relax and socialize by the water after a day of racing.
- **Saturday Evening | Evening Event** – Fun activities for participants and families.
- **Sunday, 16 August | Prize Giving Ceremony** – Celebrate the winners with a three-course dinner and awards.
